FIREWOOD

A By-Law Relating to the Sale of Firewood in the Town

BE IT ENACTED: By the Town Council of the Town of Hartland as follows:

1. No person shall sell or offer for sale any firewood of whatever nature by the cord, unless such cord contains 128 cubic feet or when piled up shall measure eight feet in length, four feet in width and four feet in height, or the equivalent thereof.
2. Any person who bargains for wood to be delivered and paid for by the cord and finds himself aggrieved by short measure, shall cause the wood to be piled and shall call in the scaler appointed by the Council, at his expense, such scaler shall measure the disputed wood and his measurement shall be final and payment made accordingly, unless a mutual agreement is reached between the buyer and seller.
3. The above provisions shall not apply to wood sold by the load unless the seller specify the load contains a cord or part of a cord.
