LICENSES

A By-Law Relating to Town Licenses

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Hartland as follows:

1. All licenses for carrying on any business, trade, occupation or conducting any exhibition or amusement shall be applied for in writing, they shall be authorized by Council, and issued by the Town Clerk under the seal of the Town; every license so issued shall expire on the date set out in such license.
2. It is the duty of the Clerk to keep a record of licenses issued with the name and address of the licensee, the nature of the license and date of expiry; also to keep a duplicate of the license; to remit to the Treasurer all license fees received each month and make a report to the Council.
3. All licenses granted shall be subject to statutory authority and may be cancelled by the Council on infraction of the terms under which issued or of any By-Law in force at the time of issue, and appertaining thereto.
4. No license shall be issued until the application has paid the Clerk for the uses of the Town, the prescribed license fee, and had complied (with) the preliminary conditions to the granting thereof.
5. Every building or premises licensed shall be subject to inspection by the Mayor, Councillors, Town Marshall and members of the Police Force at all reasonable times.
6. No person shall set up, establish or keep a billiard or pool table, bowling alley, or similiar device, implement or arrangement for profit or gain unless first obtaining a license, the fees of which shall be fifteen dollars for the first table, ten dollars for the second table, and five dollars for each additional table, when contained in the same building and Ten dollars for each bowling alley, shooting gallery or similiar device so maintained and operated.
7. Every license issued under Section 7, shall be valid for one year from date of issue and shall be forfeited and cancelled if any disposal or sale of intoxicating beverages (Which, for the purpose of this By-Law shall include any essences or extracts that, in the opinion of the Council might be used as intoxicating drink, either alone or mixed

with some other ingredients), or any gambling is allowed in the building or on the premises.

8. No place of business that includes any of the amusements in Section 7 shall open before six o'clock in the forenoon, nor stay open after eleven o'clock in the afternoon, and shall be closed for all purposes from eleven o'clock Saturday evening until six o'clock Monday morning, and no person under sixteen years of age shall be allowed to frequent such place of amusement.
9. Every license shall specify the premises whereon such license is granted and such license shall not be transferable to, or available for, any person or premises than those specified.
10. The payment of a license fee under this By-Law shall be in every case in addition to and in no case shall exempt such holder from any other tax or license to which he may be subject under the By-Laws of the Town.
11. The interior of billiard and pool rooms and bowling alleys must be visible at all times from the street.
12. No exhibition of natural or artificial curiosities and no theatre, circus or any other show to which admission is charged (concerts or vocal or instrumental music excepted) shall be held without a license.
13. Any person who obtains a license shall conform to all such directions for preserving order and decorum and for public peace as the Mayor or Marshal deem necessary.
14. The following license fees shall be charged:

For circus and menagerie combined.....	\$50.00 per day
Circus, menagerie or merry-go-round.....	\$25.00 per day
Outside show, performance or exhibition.....	\$ 5.00 per day
Show in public hall, not more than 5 actors,	
First Performance.....	\$ 3.00 per day
Subsequent Performances.....	\$ 2.00 per day
Show in public hall, more than 5 actors,	
First Performance.....	\$ 5.00 per day
Subsequent Performances.....	\$ 3.00 per day

15. Before any merry-go-round or motion picture show be allowed to operate, to which admission is charged, if the Manager is a resident of Carleton County, license fees shall be paid as follows:

For Merry-go-round	\$5.00 per day
Moving Pictures, first day.....	\$2.00 per day
Moving Pictures, subsequent days.....	\$1.00 per day

16. Notwithstanding anything contained therein, the Council may authorize that a license issued for motion pictures for a term of one year at a \$50.00 fee, or if shows be held two days per week only, at \$25.00 per year or fraction thereof.

17. Additional fees, as under, will be payable when a vaudeville show is included with the motion picture show:

For 3 or less performers \$2.00 first day-\$1.00 following days
For 5 or less performers \$3.00 first day-\$1.50 following days
for 6 or less performers \$5.00 first day-\$3.00 following days

18. The license fee for a dance shall be \$50.00 per year.

19. Any person violating any provision of this By-Law shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$50.00.
